The Tibet Institute Rikon celebrates its 50th Anniversary

The Dalai Lama will come to Switzerland in September

Rikon, March 26, 2018: *This year, the Tibet Institute Rikon will celebrate its 50th anniversary. From September 21 through 24, 2018, His Holiness the Dalai Lama will participate in several events held in Rikon, Winterthur and the Hallenstadion Zürich, bestowing a unique character on all of them.*

The Dalai Lama and the Tibet Institute Rikon

Following a suggestion of the Dalai Lama, the industrial family Kuhn paved the way to the inauguration of the Tibet Institute Rikon in 1968. His Holiness assumed the role of the monastery's patron. He chooses the Abbots and assigns the monastery its major tasks. Among them, providing for the religious and cultural needs of Tibetans of all traditions in Switzerland is of key importance.

The Tibet Institute on its 50th Birthday

According to His Holiness, the Tibet Institute should be a place of mutual teaching and learning. Here, both for Tibetans and non-tibetan people, but especially for the younger generations, the task is to preserve, but also to enliven a religious and cultural heritage and to open it up to new horizons. With this mandate, the Tibet Institute moves ahead into the coming decades.

In the course of the past decades, new tasks have been added to the Institute's agenda. A scientific library was built up as a means to preserve Tibet's spiritual heritage. It serves as a basis for research at all scientific levels, and – being part of the Zürich Network of University Libraries – is accessible to the general public through internet.

The list of educational events published annually by the Institute runs up to about 100 talks and seminars on Tibetan culture and religion. The offer attracts some 2000 visitors each year, as well as some thirty classes from public schools, who visit Rikon in the framework of their interdenominational religious studies.

Dialogue between East and West

Following a suggestion by the Dalai Lama, the Tibet Institute, since many years, participates in the efforts to familiarize monks and nuns in Tibetan monasteries with Western scientific reasoning. Swiss scientists, supported by Tibetan interpreters, teach in numerous exile monasteries, but also in Rikon itself. The project is inspired by the Dalai Lama's concept according to which Tibetan Buddhism must be open to dialogue with other philosophies if it is to further develop and to contribute to a better world. At the same time, His Holiness shares our view that the Western World will be greatly enriched if it can open up to dialogue with Buddhist philosophy and spirituality.
